PURPOSE

NEEDS



MENTORS

A Mentor is someone who genuinely comes alongside some students relationally, and gives them sound spiritual advice while pointing them to Jesus.

SURFERS

- **First 20:** make 8 personal connections with students
- **Middle 35:** engage in teaching & be available for small groups
- **Last 20:** reconnect and send off students

SEEKERS

- **First 20:** have 4 meaningful conversations with students
- **Middle 35:** engage in teaching & be available for small groups
- **Last 20:** reconnect and encourage students

VERBAL CLASS HOST

- **First 20:** build relationships with students
- **Middle 35:** creatively give weekly announcements
- **Last 20:** reconnect and be available to answer questions

SERVERS

A Server is someone who can joyfully assist with some hands-on tasks and responsibilities that must be done with excellence in order for us to make the most of the opportunities we have each week.

WELCOMING CLASS HOSTS

- **First 20:** be early to welcome all students
- **Middle 35:** manage attendance sheets & head counts
- **Last 20:** reconnect with new students

CAFÉ WORKERS (7th-12th grade)

- **First 20:** sell drinks & snacks in café area
- **Middle 35:** clean up & secure all café items; engage in worship
- **Last 20:** reconnect & encourage

ACTIVITY SUPERVISOR

- **First 20:** maintain control & safety in game rooms/bball courts
- **Middle 35:** see that equipment is returned; walk thru & around building; engage in teaching & be available for small groups
- **Last 20:** reconnect & encourage students
